DR. D. A. STRICKLER NAMED PRESIDENT OF U. S. EXAMINERS

Denver Physician Elected by
National Federation at
Chicago Meeting.

Dr. David A. Strickler, one of the most widely known physicians of this city, has been elected president of the Federation of State Boards of Medical Examiners, the national body composed of the various state boards throught the country. The election took place at the annual meeting of the federation in Chicago yesterday, Dr. Strickler receiving notice today of his elevation to the office of president.

Dr. Strickler, whose home is at 1520 York street, is secretary and treasurer of the Colorado state board of medical examiners, and he has been widely known in recent years for his work in straightening out the problems of physicians from other states wishing to practice medicine here. He also has served on various committees of the national federation. He did not attend the annual meeting of the organization in Chicago, sending in his place as delegate Dr. A. C. Magruder of Colorado Springs, who wired today the news of Dr. Strickler's election.
