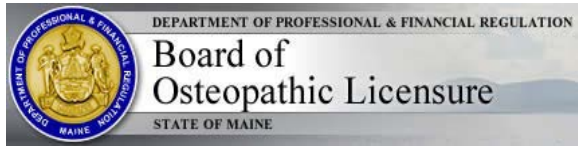


Maine Board of Osteopathic Licensure



The [Maine Board of Osteopathic Licensure](#) was established in 1919 to protect the public through the regulation of the practice of osteopathic medicine by licensing qualified applicants and maintaining high professional standards. Through

its licensing process, the board provides assurance that physicians have received a degree from an accredited college of osteopathic medicine and the appropriate level of training. Once licensed, physicians must adhere to accepted standards of professional conduct.
