

New Hampshire Board of Medicine



Created by the state legislature in 1897, the [New Hampshire Board of Medicine](#) licenses and regulates allopathic and osteopathic physicians as well as physician assistants. Originally the board was comprised of five physicians. Later a paramedical representative was added along with two public members. Today, the board consists of

11 members, including five physicians or surgeons, one osteopathic physician or surgeon, one physician assistant, three public members and the commissioner or medical director of the Department of Health and Human Services.
