Utah Physician Licensing Board Utah Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon's Board



Although laws on medical practice in Utah date back to 1921, the state's first Medical Practice Act was passed in 1969. The Physician Licensing Board was established in 1976. The Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon's Licensing Board was established in 1981 with the enactment of the Utah Osteopathic Medical Practice Act. Several Utah leaders have served as past presidents/chairs of the FSMB including: John H. Clark, M.D. (1982-83), Howard G. McQuarrie, M.D. (1987-88) and George J. Van Komen, M.D. (2001-02).
