

Virgin Islands Board of Medical Examiners

Boards and commissions in the Virgin Islands are designed to give citizens a voice in their government and provide a means of influencing decisions that shape the quality of life for residents. The Board of Medical Examiners is responsible for regulating the practice of medicine in the territory. The board is comprised of four physicians licensed to practice in the Virgin Islands; two of whom must reside in the district of St. Croix and two in the district of St. Thomas and St. John, and three members from the Virgin Islands community of recognized ability and integrity in non-medical professions, one of whom must reside on St. Croix, one on St. Thomas and one on St. John.
