## THE MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT OF NEVADA

An Act regulating the practice of medicine, surgery, and obstetrics in the State of Novada; providing for the appointment of a State Board of Medical Examiners and defining their duties; providing for the issuing of licenses to practice medicine; defining the practice of medicine; defining certain misdemeanors and providing penalties, and repealing all other Acts, or parts of Acts, in conflict therewith.

Approved March 4, 1905; as amended March 27, 1931

Section 1. That it shall hereafter be unlawful for any person, or persons, to practice medicine, surgery, or obstetrics in this State without first obtaining a license so to do as hereinafter

provided.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the Governor of the State of Nevada to appoint a State board consisting of five members, which shall be known as the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Nevada, and shall be reputable practicing physicians, duly licensed as such by some legally chartered medical institution in the United States, and who shall have been actually engaged in the practice of medicine in the State of Nevada. This board shall be selected without regard to their individual political beliefs, and they shall hold office for the time for which they were appointed, viz., two for four years, one for three years, one for three years, and one for one year from the date of their appointment and shall serve until their
